About Us: Brewster United Soccer Club, established in 1976, was created to provide a safe and fun environment for the development of youth soccer. Brewster United is a member of the East Hudson Youth Soccer League, which has more than 44 Clubs and over 15,000 players. Brewster United currently has over 300 players combined in both our in-house recreational and travel programs. We have more than 225 players on 20 teams in the four Divisions of our in-house program for players ages 4-13, and more than 90 players on our six travel teams for players Under 9 through Under 18.

Open Meetings: Brewster United holds monthly Board Meetings which are open to all. We encourage you to attend. Meetings are generally held the third or fourth Monday of each month in Brewster High School Room 106. The exact dates and times of upcoming meetings are posted on our website.

In-House Program: Here are answers to frequently asked questions about our in-house program (Note that for all Divisions, your age is calculated by how old you are on July 31)--

Clinic: For boys and girls ages 4 and 5.

Teams generally play every Saturday afternoon during the season from 1pm – 2pm. Teams play 5 against 5, with no goalie, and no referee.

Division 3: For girls and boys ages 6 and 7.

Teams practice one or more times/week, and generally play a game every Sunday morning during the season. Teams play 8 against 8, including a goalie. A referee will officiate the game.

Division 2: For girls and boys ages 8 and 9.

Other information is the same as Division 3.

Division 1: For girls and boys ages 10 through 13.

Teams practice one or more times/week, and generally play a game every Sunday morning during the season. Teams play 10 against 10, including a goalie. A referee will officiate the game.
